COLONEL E.H. TAYLOR, JR. STRAIGHT RYE WHISKEY RECEIVES FIRST PLACE BEST OF SHOW AT NORTH AMERICAN BOURBON & WHISKEY COMPETITION

20 Whiskies from Buffalo Trace Distillery Honored

FRANKFORT, KY (Sept. 9, 2020) – Colonel E.H. Taylor, Jr Straight Rye Whiskey received the highest honor at the 2021 North American Bourbon & Whiskey Competition (NABWC), named the Best of Show First Place recipient. Nineteen other Buffalo Trace Distillery whiskies were awarded medals, including 12 Gold medals, four Silver medals and three Bronze medals.

The NABWC, which was founded in 2014, promotes excellence in bourbon, whiskey, and moonshine through a double-blind competition and is based on a 100-point scale. The spirits are judged by styles and price categories.
